The Canfield Business Honors Program (Canfield BHP) at Texas McCombs is an innovative degree program designed to provide intellectual challenge and professional development for students with exceptional academic abilities and leadership skills. The program is highly selective, with an admittance rate of 13 percent. There are approximately 525 students in the program.

In the fall of 2019, Canfield BHP welcomed its first Texas CSB, or Honors Computer Science and Business, class. Texas CSB is an integrated honors degree program between Canfield BHP and the Department of Computer Science aimed at a wide range of students interested in data analytics, marketing analytics, financial engineering, entrepreneurship, and leadership roles in tech companies. We currently have 20-25 students in the first two Texas CSB cohorts and expect this program to grow to 40 students per cohort over the next two years.

Most Canfield BHP students pursue a second major. The majority of these will do so inside the business school, but many others will choose a major outside the business school. About 20 percent of Canfield BHP students are dual majors in Plan II, the Liberal Arts honors program.

The Canfield BHP core curriculum includes classes across all business disciplines. Canfield BHP classes are case-based and include analytical exercises and group work. The Canfield BHP's accelerated core courses are modeled after MBA courses and are taught by the McCombs School's most highly regarded professors. The Canfield BHP curriculum and corresponding programming are designed to develop students into confident leaders.
